Running Start Equivalency/Requirements

Running Start students need to fulfill all graduation requirements set by OHS to earn their diploma. College credits are converted to OHS credits at a 5:1 ratio, meaning that five college credits count as one OHS credit. It's important for students to meet with their high school counselor each quarter before they register for college classes.

To be eligible for graduation, all necessary coursework for Oroville High School <u>must be finished by the</u> end of the winter quarter.
