Running Start Equivalency/Requirements

Running Start students need to fulfill all graduation requirements set by THS to earn their diploma. College credits are converted to THS credits at a 5:1 ratio, meaning that five college credits count as one THS credit. It's important for students to meet with their high school counselor each quarter before they register for college classes.

To be eligible for graduation, all necessary coursework for Tonasket High School <u>must be finished by the</u> end of the winter quarter.
