Running Start Equivalencies/Requirements

To qualify for Running Start, a student must be of junior standing. Running Start students must meet all EHS graduation requirements to receive a diploma from EHS. Students are required to check in with the school Counselor every quarter prior to registration at the college. College credits transfer to EHS on a 5:1 ratio.

5 credits WVC = 1.0 credits EHS

4 credits WVC = .8 credits EHS

3 credits WVC = .6 credits EHS

2 credits WVC = .4 credits EHS

1 credits WVC = .2 credits EHS

All coursework needed to fulfill Entiat High School graduation requirements **MUST** be complete by the end of the winter quarter to be eligible to participate in graduation.
