- I will be unable to get a TPD discharge of the new loan(s) based on the disabling condition I already have as of the date I submit this form, unless the condition significantly deteriorates in the future.
- Any loans discharged in the last 3 years (within the post-discharge monitoring period) will lose their discharge status and the repayment obligation will be reinstated. As such, I will be required to repay those loans along with any newly borrowed loans as normal once my repayment period begins.
